



Minnesota State senior Samantha Bergmann of New Ulm named Northern Sun Conference's Women's Golfer of the Week

Mankato, Minn. --- Minnesota State senior **Samantha Bergmann** has been named *Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference Women's Golfer of the Week*.

Bergmann, a New Ulm, Minn., native was the medalist at Concordia Invitational after shooting rounds of 75 and 76 for a 36-hole total of 151. She was seven-over par on the par-72, 5,824-yard lay-out at the Wildflower Golf Course in Detroit Lakes, Minn. Bergmann finished six strokes in front of the second-place finisher as the Mavericks, who combined to shoot rounds of 324 and 320 for 644 total, finished one stroke behind Southwest Minnesota State in the final team standings. A total of 13 schools competed in the two-day tournament.
