MLC takes UMAC tournament title at home

NEW ULM - For the first time in school history, the Martin Luther College women's basketball team is UMAC tournament champions.

The Knights held a 15-point lead in the second half, but the University of Minnesota, Morris Cougars didn't give up and rallied back to tie the game with four minutes remaining.

However, the Knights shut out the Cougars in the final minutes and held on for a 69-63 victory on Saturday night.

Erica Babinec was named conference tournament Most Valuable Player, and rightfully so.

Babinec led the Knights with 22 points and grabbed a team-high 14 rebounds.

For Babinec, it wasn't all about her, but her teammates as well.

"It just feels great that we did this as a team," the senior guard said. "We played awesome as a team. Everyone stepped it up tonight, everyone played their heart out. It was great."

The Knights never were behind in the game and they quickly jumped out to a 6-0 lead with a jumper from Babinec and two more scores from Brittney Gossen.

Babinec hit another jumper midway through the first half to give the Knights their biggest lead of the half and she hit yet another jump shot with 4:27 remaining to give the Knights a 35-23 advantage. The Cougars went on a 6-2 run to finish the half. However, the Knights took an eight-point lead into the locker room.

MLC went up by 14 with a 3-pointer from Babinec just one minute into the second half and the Knights increased that lead to 15 after a basket from Emily Boldt.

The scoring stayed steady until the Cougars started knocking down everything with just under 10 minutes to play.

The Knights held a 61-49 lead after a bucket from Hannah Hackbarth, but it was all Cougars for the next six minutes.

UMM went on a 11-0 run and just like that it was anyone's game.

"They came back at us," MLC head coach Larry Czer said. "We threw the ball away and took some bad shots."

Alex Anthon finally ended the six-minute drought with a layup with 4:12 remaining. UMM kept rolling with a trey from Allie Sannes, but the Cougars ran out of gas after that.

Gossen hit four free throws and Amanda Burk added two more at the stripe in the final minute and the Knights held on for the victory.

"We kind of settled down a little bit down the stretch," Czer said. "We made some great defensive stops down here late and I think that was the key for us."

Burk posted a double-double for the Knights, scoring 13 points and adding 12 rebounds. Gossen finished with 10 points and five rebounds.

Emily Mehr led the Cougars with 21 points.

MLC received an automatic spot into the NCAA Division III Tournament with the victory and will have to wait until the bracket is announced on Monday to see who it plays.

Knights Top Cougars to Win UMAC Tourney Title

NEW ULM, Minn. - The MLC women's basketball team beat Minnesota, Morris by the score of 69-63 Saturday night to win the UMAC Postseason Tournament championship and advance to the NCAA Division III National Tournament.

The game was as close as expected between the conference co-champions from the regular season, with MLC holding a lead for much of the way before winning the second UMAC Tournament title in program history, and the first since the 2005-06 season.

The Knights started the game hot from the field, taking a 6-0 lead on the way to a 37-29 halftime lead. Erica Babinec was the shooting star for MLC in the half, scoring a game-high 12 points before the break. The Knights built the lead to 61-49 with 9:53 to play in the game before the defending tournament champs from UMM made an 11-0 run to cut the deficit to one, and then tied the game at 63-63 with a three-pointer from Allie Sannes with 4:02 to play.

Following several stops from both teams, the Knights took the lead with 2:46 to play on a pair of Brittney Gossen free throws, and then shut the Cougars out the rest of the way while icing the game away with four free throws in the final minute.

Free throws were a big story in the game, with MLC finishing the night 18-18 from the charity stripe, while the Cougars were only able to get to the line five times in the game, making four of them.

Babinec finished with a game-high 22 points and grabbed 14 rebounds, helping her win Most Valuable Player honors for the tournament. In the two games, Babinec averaged 17 points and 12.5 rebounds per game.

Amanda Burk joined Babinec with a double-double, scoring 13 points and grabbing 12 rebounds. Brittney Gossen added ten points and five rebounds.

The Cougars were led by Emily Mehr, who finished with 21 points and five rebounds. Jenni Noordmans added nine points, seven rebounds and three steals.

With the win, MLC heads into the NCAA Division III Tournament with a record of 20-7, while UMM finished its season with a record of 18-9.

MLC will find out its tournament match-up and destination on Monday, February 27, when the selection show airs on d3hoops.com at 1:30 p.m.

Knights advance to UMAC championship game with 69-60 win against Vikings

NEW ULM - The Martin Luther College women's basketball team advanced to the Upper Midwest Athletic Conference tournament championship game with a 69-60 victory over Bethany Lutheran College in the first round of the UMAC tournament on Wednesday.

After splitting the UMAC regular season championship with the University of Minnesota-Morris, a coin toss was needed to determine the No. 1 seed for the tournament. The Knights won the coin toss, which set up their first round matchup with the No. 4 seeded Bethany Lutheran College squad and ensured them home court advantage throughout the tournament.

The two teams traded baskets for the first six minutes of the game as the score was tied up at 9-9 with 14:00 remaining in the first half.

The Knights went up by double digits on a layup by freshman Alex Anthon with 8:10 remaining in the first half that put MLC ahead by a 27-16 score.

The Knights maintained about a 10-point lead for the rest of the first half, and when the horn went off to signal the halftime break the scoreboard showed MLC leading by a score of 40-32.

The Knights came out of the locker room a little cold. It took them three minutes to make their first field goal of the second half.

While the Knights were trying to find the basket, the Vikings put together a run, and all of a sudden the Knights lead had dwindled to 44-42 with 14:00 remaining in the game.

However, the Knights came right back with a 9-0 run of their own to push the lead back to double digits.

The closest the Vikings would come again was five points, and the Knights extended their lead to as many as 15 points on a layup by forward Amanda Burk with 2:05 remaining in the game.

The final buzzer sounded with the Knights on top by a score of 69-60.

Senior forward Emily Boldt scored only six points on the night, but she played what could be said to be her best game of the season. Boldt was a defensive presence inside for the Knights, leading the team with five blocks. She also handled the task of guarding Bethany's leading scorer, Jessica Englund, for much of the night, holding Englund to 15 points on the night.

"It was a fantastic defensive performance by Emily [Boldt] tonight," Knights head coach Larry Czer said. "She just really stepped it up tonight as a senior. I think her shot blocking intimidated them a little bit, and she gave us a huge boost emotionally as well."

Anthon led the Knights in scoring with 17 points on the night, while Burk added 15 points and seven rebounds and senior guard Erica Babinec added 12 points and 11 rebounds for a double-double.

"Tonight just feels great," Boldt said. "The crowd was loud and that really helped pump us up. It feels good to get this one out of the way, but now we have to get back to business and start preparing for Morris on Saturday."

The Knights (19-7) will play at home at 7 p.m. on Saturday against the University of Minnesota-Morris for the UMAC tournament championship.

MLC women enter playoffs as top seed

NEW ULM - The four seniors on the Martin Luther College basketball team have seen no shortage of success on the court during their careers.

Now entering their final Upper Midwest Athletic Conference tournament campaign, the best of that success is perhaps still yet to come.

Although MLC has qualified for the UMAC playoffs each year that seniors Erica Babinec, Emily Boldt, Kadie Drake and Sarah Free have been on the team, the Knights (18-7 overall, 12-2 in the UMAC) earned their first ever No. 1 seed in the playoffs this season by earning a share of the conference title with the University of Minnesota, Morris (17-8, 12-2).

"We've never been in this position," Boldt said. "We've made the conference tournament every year that us four seniors have been here, but we've never been the No. 1 seed and we've never won the whole thing. So obviously that's our main goal as a team, to get to that point and come out with a victory over the whole conference.

MLC was hardly fazed by any opponent during its spectacular regular season run as it outperformed its third-place preseason ranking. However, the Knights know that playing as the top seed will bring a different dynamic as they enter the tournament.

"It definitely shows that people are going to be out there trying to get us, because we are a No. 1 seed and we're going to have to come out there strong every game," Babinec said. "We'll be playing tough teams, so we just have to keep our effort up how we've been playing all season and keep it going."

The Knights will open the UMAC tournament at 7:30 p.m. tonight at home against Bethany Lutheran (8-17, 7-7), a team they have already defeated twice this season.

"They're a tough ball club, they've gotten better as the season's progressed," MLC head coach Larry Czer said. "Both times we played them we've had rough first halves, so I'm hoping we can put two pretty good halves together and give us a little more breathing room."

Even though the Knights won by at least 10 points in each victory against the Vikings this season, they aren't taking anything for granted entering tonight's matchup.

"Every night you have to come and play, and we know that, because any team can really beat any team in this conference," Free said. "We've beaten Bethany twice now, but it's hard to beat a team three times, so that's why we just have to come ready for (tonight)."

Morris will host St. Scholastica tonight in the tournament's other semifinal. If the Knights defeat Bethany, their position as the top seed means that they will host the conference championship game at 7 p.m. on Saturday.

"It's nice for us to be playing at home," Czer said. "At this point in the season it's really tough to win on the road. I think that is a big advantage for us, especially against Morris if we do happen to win (tonight). Being able to host Morris at home is a big advantage."

Czer mentioned that the most important thing for his team heading into the playoffs will be to keep to its main strengths - taking care of the ball, playing smart basketball and playing intense defense.

"I think defense is huge," Drake said. "We've had terrible nights shooting and we've come out on top because of our defense. Coach (Paul) Holzhuetter always says turn it into points, and that's what we need to keep doing in order to win the next few games."

Though this is the first time MLC has entered the UMAC playoffs as the No. 1 seed and it is the first time the school has earned a regular season UMAC title, the Knights won the tournament as the No. 4 seed in 2006.

Since then the team hasn't lacked talented players, but until this season it had failed to have a similarly successful season.

This year's team meshed together well with its blend of veteran leadership and younger players that made an immediate impact.

"I think that throughout the years we've always had the talent and we've always had a shot, we just haven't put it all together," Boldt said. "This year we've figured it out and that's why I think we're seeing a lot of success this season."

The Knights knew very early on in the year that they were in for a special season after they emerged from a strong preseason campaign and won the first nine games of their conference schedule.

"I think a lot of it had to do with preseason, just how we were beating upper Division III and lower Division II teams," Drake said. "I think that said a lot about how conference was going to go for us this year."

Though a poor performance could bring a disappointing end to MLC's remarkable season, Czer isn't worried about his players cracking under the pressure.

"We're a very steady team emotionally, and that's been great," Czer said. "We don't get too high when we win, we don't get too low when we lose, and that's a great thing. When you can do that day in and day out, they're going to play solid basketball, no matter what."

Drake demonstrated the team's ability to think of the bigger picture by reasoning that, although a UMAC tournament championship would be an ideal end to the careers of herself and her fellow seniors, at the end of the day basketball is only a small part of why they are at MLC.

"I mean, we all realize - not just us four seniors, but everybody - that we're here for a much greater purpose," Drake said. "So win or lose, we have to keep that in mind that we're here for a much different purpose... we can't be too disappointed if we lose because we have much more to look forward to in our future."
