- 1. The list above includes only sanctioned 300 games. The first recorded 300 game was bowled by bowling legend Riley Dahms in 1936 at the Concordia Lanes on State Street. He bowled it on lanes 1-2 in practice. New Ulm Bowling Annual, 1956. Additional details may be available in 1936 Brown County Journal or New Ulm Review.
- 2. The first 300 bowled in a league was recorded by Erwin (Toots) Cordes 3-13-1941 at Concordia State Street lanes in the Home League which was the second level in the progressive bowling leauges at the time. The league had chosen not to sanction that year. Toots had games of 199-199-300 for a 698 series. *New Ulm Bowling annual, 1956.* George Walden also bowled a non-sanction 300 game 12/31/1966 at George's. He bowled the game on lanes 1-2 during the weekly informal jackpot bowling. Two years later he was bowling with Fritz Aufderheide when he made his 300.
- 3. While other 300 game in non-league bowling have been rolled, the last publicly reported one was Sunday, Aug. 4, 1957 by Linus Neidecker at the Bowl-O-Mat. He had games of 213-300-191. New Ulm Bowling Annual, 1958.
- 4. The New Ulm Bowling Annual 1956 recognized Ed Meyer for recording 15 consecutive strikes without getting a 300. Bowling in the Straightaway at Concordia, he ended his first game with six strikes (including three in 10th). He had nine straight to open the second game before running into a 4-5 split in the 10th. All strikes were 1-3 pocket hits except one.
- 5. A number of 299 games have been recorded as an official ABC/USBC award worthy of a ring and patch. Daren Zanke rolled a 299 Jan. 27, 2011, tapping out the 10th. Also of note is a 299 bowled by Cathedral Athletic director John Vetter April 5, 1972 in Windom where he worked. He also tapped the 12th ball and finished with a series of 214-235-299 for 748. It came a week afer Marlyn Sellner bowled his 300 in New Ulm. If provided, info on other sanctioned 299 or 298 games is welcomed and will be added to the website archives by New Ulm Sports Central and are noted on the USBC site. Also of noted achievements is 11 strikes in a row which would honor those who didn't get nine or eight pins on the last ball. Les Geiger, one of the 300 bowlers, had such a game in the Sioux League in 2007, missing a 300 in the 10th frame.
- **6.** Major New Ulm Bowling History may be have been included in two research works which have become lost. An extensive copy of decades of material was loaned for a bowler's banquet by Red Wyczawski. Whereabouts of this material as well as that gathered by Jeff Rose is not known. Please provide information to New ulm Sports Central.
- 7. Torvik bowled two 300 games in January, 2011. He had a perfect game at Granite Bowl South in St. Cloud in the Bischoff tournament with games of 219-256-300=775.
